A leper comes to Jesus and wants to be healed. This is Jesus' ministry from the very beginning of Mark's gospel. Some scholars feel Jesus is a bit frustrated at this moment of healing. I wonder why he tells the healed leper to go wash in the Jordan? Our Lord shows compassion by healing the diseased man, and the healing restores him to his community and temple. There is also the secretive motif of not telling anyone. There is much to ponder in this healing story.

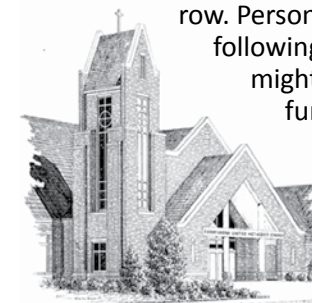
